We have been made aware that a decision concerning the above stated applications will be carried forth by the esteemed Mayor and Council Members on January 12, 2026. We understand that Joel and Allanah L'Ecuyer have completed all of the Township's required conditions which includes a full ecological report.

Our concerns run deeper than requirements met on a piece of paper, our apprehensions stem from the actual outcomes and environmental consequences that will result from the building of 3 large residences, potentially destroying a small, pristine lake. A lake, I might add, that is enjoyed by thousands of tourists and Seguin Township residents along the Seguin Trail each year.

Seguin Township Website for 2026 and beyond states clearly that *Seguin's Foundation is to protect, preserve and invest in our natural environment.* It further states as a goal, *To advocate for more attainable housing in Seguin.* Finally, it says, *Trails Master Plan guides how we plan, design, fund, build and maintain Seguin's trail system.*

Looking closely at your own words, we ask you to consider how building 3 elite residences on or near a fragile lake ecosystem along a beloved trail system meets any of Seguin Township's Strategic Plan for 2026 and beyond. Is the potential risk to this pristine ecosystem that serves thousands annually worth the price of 3 minimal tax incomes?
