

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN

BY-LAW NO. 2025-078

Being a By-law to prescribe Fees and Charges for Various Fire and By-law Services Provided by The Corporation of the Township of Seguin and to Repeal By-law No. 2024-121 and all other By-laws and Resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25 as amended, Part XII, Section 391(1), a municipality may pass by-laws to impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board, and for the use of its property including property under its control;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Seguin has determined that it is reasonable to require the costs of providing various products and services be covered by fees or charges paid by the applicant and not borne by the ratepayers in general;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to By-law No. 2003-03, amended by By-law No. 2023-115, of The Corporation of the Township of Seguin, a By-law to prescribe the form and manner and times for the provision of Notice under the Municipal Act, notice of intent to pass this By-law was provided by posting on the Township of Seguin website on September 25th, 2025 and in the Township of Seguin Municipal Office.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT COUNCIL FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** fees for various Fire and By-law Services and documents shall be set out in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this By-law.
2. **THAT** under Special Circumstances the above noted fees may be waived by the Chief Administrative Officer or the Fire Chief.
3. **THAT** By-law No. 2024-121 and all other By-laws, Resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

4. THAT this By-law shall come into full force and effect on January 1st, 2026.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, PASSED and ENACTED this 6th day of October, 2025.

(F) Open-burning Permits (requiring Site Visit by Fire Department Staff)	\$100.00
(G) Open Air Burning By-law Infractions (emergency response required)	Current MTO Rates for fire response services
(H) Railroad Call Outs for Fire, on or beside tracks, as a result of Railway Operations and the subsequent failure to extinguish those fires	Current MTO Rates for fire response services
(I) Calls Out to Trees on Hydro Line when no fire is present and Hydro Delayed more than 30 minutes from alarm notification	Current MTO Rates for fire response services
(J) Application to Change Road Name	\$400.00
(K) Insurance Request Letter identifying fire coverage levels in area	\$35.00 (Occurrence Reports are to be issued through Municipal FOI requests)
(L) All Seguin Fire Hall Meeting Rooms	\$75.00/half day (4 hours or less) \$150.00/day (Note: No kitchen facilities available)

(M) Response to Marine Incidents on local lakes for non-residence	Current MTO Rates for fire response services
(N) Request for Fire Department to attend private events with no Public Education display	Current MTO Rates for fire response services
(M) Request for By-Law Officer's to attend private events to direct or manage traffic or provide access control	\$140.00/hour minimum 4 hours
