THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of the Zoning By-law Amendment is to rezone an Environmental Protection Zone to an Environmental Protection exception zone to permit a private road to be constructed and implement an Environmental Impact Study.

Please refer to the next page of this Notice for a description of the land or a key map showing the land to which the zoning by-law would apply.

All written and oral public input was taken into consideration when the merits of this Planning Act application was determined with appropriate measures being included as conditions of approval where required as part of the decision of the approval authority.

If applicable, the last date for filing a notice of appeal of the by-law is May 18th, 2026.

Take notice that an appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal may be made by filing a notice of appeal with the Clerk either via the Ontario Land Tribunal e-file service (first-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account) at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service> by selecting Seguin Township as the Approval Authority or by email to info@seguin.ca or by mail to 5 Humphrey Drive, Seguin ON, P2A 2W8 no later than 4:30 p.m. on **the 18th day of May, 2026**. The filing of an appeal after 4:30 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. The notice of appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal and must be accompanied by the fee required by the Ontario Land Tribunal. The fee can be paid online through e-file or by certified cheque/money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the By-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Council or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
